With WINGS support, recent high school graduates of the Northfield TORCH Program are receiving on-the-job training through the Minnesota Reading Corps while simultaneously taking college courses through Riverland Community College right here in Northfield. Riverland is partnering with HCI and TORCH and this collaboration allows students to earn an Associate of Arts degree while earning a stipend, gaining workforce skills, and building a community of young professionals right here at home. Our hope is that this experience will ensure that more TORCH graduates will become educators and return to Northfield for their careers. This is the home of the creative, new collaboration: TORCH + Riverland + Minnesota Reading Corps.

Family School







Family School, a collaboration between Dakota Prairie Adult Basic Education and Northfield Early Childhood Family Education, is working to meet needs for adults 17 and older who are not enrolled in school and are functioning below the 12th grade level. All of the participants are women and English language learners with children. Often it is a family's introduction to the public school system, thus connecting them to high quality education and resources.

Family School offers free classes in English as a Second Language, GED test preparation, workplace literacy, family literacy, transitions to postsecondary education and basic adult literacy including reading, writing, and math. Additionally, Family School provides instruction in citizenship and digital

literacy. Classes are held at the Northfield Community Resource Center with satellite locations at Greenvale Park Community School and Emmaus Church.

By engaging with the early childhood programming, families are supported and a trusting relationship is built with the child's school. The early childhood outreach specialist connects families with important services and programming and also provides home visits twice a year. Consistent communication between early childhood staff and families helps children progress through programming and remain connected to the community.

WINGS supports these efforts with funding for transportation to and from Family School that nearly all of the families utilize throughout the year. Attendance and success in the classes has led to improved scores on the Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment Systems Test and increased kindergarten readiness. An unanticipated outcome during last year's academic year was a new relationship with the Northfield Public Library after a visit from the outreach coordinator.

What's Your Legacy?

WINGS recently hosted a public event about legacy giving, featuring speaker Mariah Brook, Philanthropic Advisor, Saint Paul & Minnesota Foundations. Ms. Brook spoke about the power of planned giving and endowed gifts and told stories of impact. She celebrated the incredible success of WINGS and helped us to consider how we might thoughtfully leave a legacy for this great work to continue well into the future.

Legacy or planned gifts are just that – planned. Individuals plan to pass on their values and goals in the form of ongoing financial support. Legacy donations to WINGS funds support that commitment in perpetuity. Ms. Brook discussed ways to plan a legacy gift, large or small, that will support the donor during their life and later support Northfield women and youth for generations to come. The legacy a person strategically plants now is both relational and financial, and both are needed to sustain impact in the community.

During a Q&A panel WINGS members shared their stories of legacy giving and how their plan reflects the legacy they wish to leave. They spoke about family history which has shaped their giving and what they find is the most satisfying part of giving.

Complimentary bags of B&W Coffee featuring "Molly's Legacy Blend," were given to thank those attending and to honor the memory of Molly Woehrlin, a founding WINGS member. Her legacy gift to WINGS continues to inspire and support women and youth.
